1. FELLOWSHIP IN CLINICAL NEPHROLOGY

DURATION: 2 YEARS

Admission Requirements

- i. Hold a Masters of Medicine degree in Internal Medicine of the University of Nairobi or an equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate.
- ii. Be registrable with Kenya's Medical Practitioners and Dentists Board.
- iii. Applicants whose medium of communication for their basic medical degree was not English, will be required to show evidence of proficiency in English language.
- iv. Possess a valid professional indemnity cover during the full period of training.
- v. Be bound to conduct themselves with integrity in a manner befitting the medical profession and in accordance with the following documents:
 - a. Manual on Code of Conduct and medical ethics.

b. Public officer's Ethic Act, 2003 Part III general Code of Conduct and Ethics.

2. MASTER OF MEDICINE IN UROLOGY

Admission Requirements

Candidates shall be holders of Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery Degree of the University of Nairobi, or an equivalent qualification from a recognized institution approved by the University Senate.

Evidence of registration or eligibility to be registered by Medical Practitioner's and Dentists Board in Kenya.

Evidence of retention on the list of the Medical Practitioner's and Dentists Board.

Possess a certificate of good conduct from the Kenya Medical Practitioners and Dentists Board or any equivalent authority from the country of origin.

Valid professional indemnity cover.

3. DIPLOMA IN RENAL NURSING

DURATION: 1 YEAR

Admission Requirements

i. Diploma in Nursing (KRN/M, KRCHN). The candidate must be registrable by a professional body of Nursing.

OR

ii. Holders of Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from the University of Nairobi or an equivalent qualification approved by Senate. The applicants should be registrable by a professional body of Nursing

AND

iii. Must have a minimum of Two years of Nursing practice experience

AND

iv. At least C plain at KCSE or equivalent

v. Equivalent qualifications from the four East Africa Community Countries including Uganda, Tanzania, Burundi and Rwanda shall be considered

4. RENAL PRECEPTORSHIP COURSES

DURATION: 12 WEEKS

1. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN RENAL NUTRITION

1.1 Be at least a diploma level holder in Food Science, Nutrition and Dietetics related courses.

AND

1.2 Have Nutrition and Dietetics work experience of at least one year from a recognized institution;

1.3 Be registered with Kenya Nutrition and Dietetics Institute (KNDI).

1.4 At least C plain at KCSE or equivalent and a pass in English

2. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN RENAL LABORATORY

2.1 Holders of Bachelor of Science Degree in Medical Laboratory Sciences from a recognized university or an equivalent qualifications. The applicants should be registered by the relevant regulatory body.

OR

2.2 Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences. The candidate must be registered by the relevant regulatory body

3. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN RENAL NURSING

3.1 Holders of Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from the University of Nairobi or an equivalent qualification approved by Senate. The applicants should be registered/registrable by a professional body of Nursing.

OR

3.2 Diploma in Nursing (KRN, KRN/M, KRCHN). The candidate must be registered/registrable by a professional body of Nursing.

AND

3.3 Must have a minimum of Two years of clinical nursing practice experience

AND

3.4 At least C plain at KCSE or equivalent and a pass in English

4. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN RENAL PHARMACY PRACTICE (PRPP)

4.1 A minimum of Bachelor of Pharmacy degree from the University of Nairobi or an equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by University of Nairobi Senate

4.2 Be a registered pharmacist with Pharmacy and Poisons Board or equivalent body.

4.3 Have relevant work experience of at least one year post registration.

5. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN DIALYSIS FOR PHYSICIANS AND MEDICAL OFFICERS

Candidates should be holders of Bachelor MBchB degree or its equivalent from a recognized university or an equivalent qualifications.

6. PRECEPTORSHIP COURSE IN DIALYSIS ACCESS
